



Little Blessings Dressings Covid Plan

Little Blessings Dressings will follow all CDC/federal/local guidelines. We have been in close contact with the Washington County Fairgrounds and will adhere to all rules regarding occupancy limits. In addition, we have made the following adjustments to each part of our sale week:

Drop off:

- We are setting up a day earlier, so that we can begin our drop off appointments earlier. We will have more time slots available on Monday/Tuesday. There will be more time in between appointments with fewer consignors dropping off during each time slot.
- All consignors and working consignors will be required to wear masks. Hand sanitizer will be available. Gloves will also be available for working consignors.
- Stain checking stations will be spaced at least 6 feet apart.
- We have created a check list for returning consignors that will be emailed out ahead of time to decrease the time spent at the check in table.
- We will check in with all new consignors ahead of time to answer any questions about drop off (to again decrease the time spent at the check in table).
- There will be no drop off of large items at the front table. Consignors will take large items directly to the sales floor.
- Consignors will have the opportunity to use rolling racks (as available) to help with putting away clothing in a timelier fashion.
- There will be no paper presale passes given at check in as we will utilize electronic passes through Ticket Leap.
- All pens will be sanitized between uses.
- There will be increased cleaning and sanitizing of frequently touched areas.

During sale:

- All shoppers and working consignors will be required to wear masks.
- Disposable gloves will be available for workers
- We have added the ability to accept contactless payments at our credit card machines. We have encouraged shoppers to use a credit card if possible—we prefer NO CASH.
- Three out of the four checkout counters will have external pin pads to limit contact.
- We will utilize appointment shopping through Ticket Leap to control capacity. There will be a limited number of walk-up appointments available.
- Shoppers will be asked to bring their own bags.
- There will be hand sanitizer at the entrance, exit, and at each register.
- Plexiglass barriers will be utilized at each check out counter.
- Pens will be sanitized between uses.
- Floor markers will be used to remind people to stay six feet apart in line.
- Social distancing signs and reminders will be hung throughout the building.
- There will be increased cleaning and sanitizing of frequently touched areas.

Pick up:

- We will be utilizing pick up appointments to control the number of people in the building at a time.
- All working consignors and consignors will be required to wear a mask. Hand sanitizer will be available. Gloves will also be available for working consignors.
